

# Neighborhood Traffic Management Program (NTMP)



## What is NTMP?

NTMP stands for Neighborhood Traffic Management Program. A NTMP identifies the cause of neighborhood traffic and safety issues, and determines feasible traffic calming and safety solutions. It is a program adopted by jurisdictions to enhance and protect the quality of living by making neighborhoods safer for pedestrians, bicyclists, and motorists.

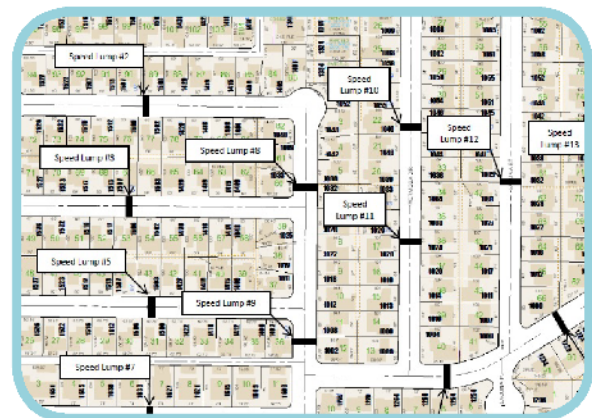
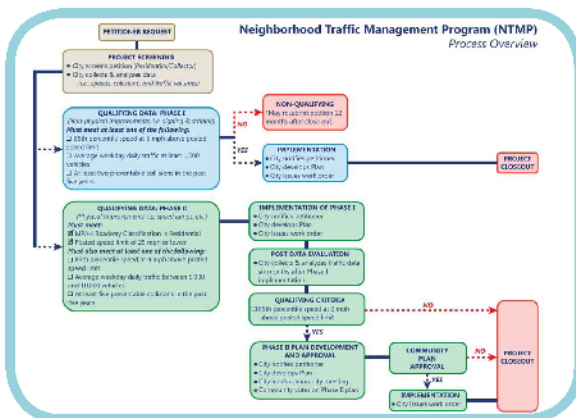
## What does a jurisdiction need to do to implement their own NTMP?

- **Establish procedures** for a resident petition process
- **Provide a tool box** with different devices which may be used to address neighborhood traffic related concerns
- **Establish policies** to be adopted by the City council

- **Streamline** petition & approval processing procedures
- **Develop** forms for petition submittal and other communications
- **Develop** prioritization criteria & tools to help process petitions

- **Generate and update** frequently asked questions (FAQ's) and responses
- **Update** the NTMP document with a new layout and improved graphics
