Neighborhood Traffic Management Program (NTMP)



What is NTMP?

NTMP stands for Neighborhood Traffic Management Program. A NTMP identifies the cause of neighborhood traffic and safety issues, and determines feasible traffic calming and safety solutions. It is a program adopted by jurisdictions to enhance and protect the quality of living by making neighborhoods safer for pedestrians, bicyclists, and motorists.

What does a jurisdiction need to do to implement their own NTMP?

- Establish procedures for a resident petition process
- Provide a tool box with different devices which may be used to address neighborhood traffic related concerns
- Establish policies to be adopted by the City council
