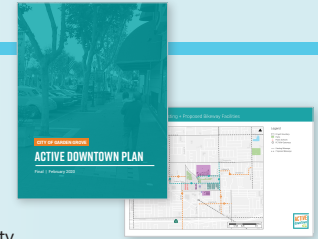
What are Complete Streets?

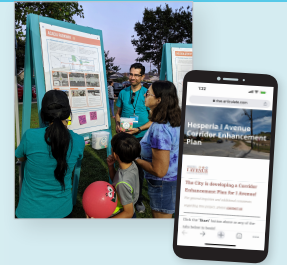
Planning

KOA has developed dozens of award-winning Active Transportation Plans, Bicycle Master Plans, Pedestrian Master Plans, Safe Routes to School Plans, General Plan Circulation Elements, First/Last Mile Plans, and Long Range Transportation Plans across Southern California. Our planners, designers, and engineers are at the forefront of multimodal mobility best practices, including those in curb management and micromobility.



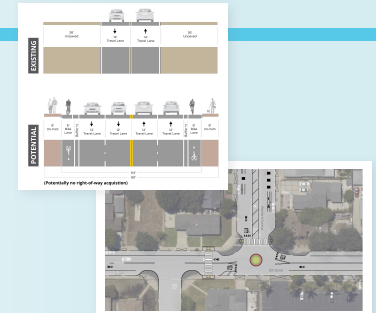
Community Engagement

Representing the diversity of Southern California, our staff are fluent in multiple languages and specialize in the development of in-person and online engagement methods. From GIS-based map surveys, customized and graphically expressive webpages, to in-person facilitation, KOA staff convey Complete Streets policies and improvements in ways that are interactive, jargon-free, and engaging. A key strength in our engagement strategies is our ability to develop full-scale demonstration projects that let people directly experience potential walking, biking, and multi-modal infrastructure improvements.



Design

The key component to KOA's Complete Streets practice is in the development of conceptual design drawings that directly implement the policy and infrastructure recommendations of our plan documents. This includes planning-level concepts, quick-build projects for expedited implementation, and full plans and specifications for permanent facilities. These services are often included as part of the development of our Active Transportation, Complete Streets and Safe Routes to School Plans.



Implementation

Advancing Complete Streets plans and projects to construction, KOA staff includes a full team of grant writers that have successfully obtained over \$180 million dollars in funding for our clients. Our team also includes construction managers who can oversee the construction of these projects once funding is obtained.
